

MINUTES
Of a Special Meeting of the
VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
March 15, 2018

The special meeting of the Village Board of Piper City was brought to order at the Village Hall on March 15, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Jeff Orr presiding. All trustees were personally served written notice of the special meeting at least 48 hours prior to the meeting by Mayor Orr on March 13, 2018. Trustees Fuoss, Houck, Bertrand, Cotter, and Berry responded to roll call. Mogged was absent.

Mayor Orr invited public comments but there were none.

The purpose of the special meeting was to consider an ordinance to amend Section 33.06 of the Village Code concerning liquor licenses. The "Class F" combined liquor license ordinance would amend the Village Code to allow a gas station convenience store to sell package liquor at retail for consumption off the premises and to sell beer and wine for consumption on the premises in a separate room set aside for that purpose and for video gambling. Houck made a motion to approve the ordinance and Cotter seconded. On a roll call vote all trustees voted aye and the ordinance was approved as Ordinance 2018-2.

Mayor Orr reported on a peddler permit issued earlier in the day to Illinois Gas & Electric.

Motion for adjournment was made by Fuoss, seconded by Bertrand. Motion carried and the meeting was adjourned at 7:06 p.m.
